#### State Structure

Delinquency services in Massachusetts are organized at the both the state and local level. Secure detention and state commitments are both administered by the Department of Youth Services (DYS) within the Massachusetts Department of Health and Human Services, a state-level executive agency. Community supervision is administered by the Office of Commissioner of Probation a state judicial agency, across 11 local divisions. Aftercare services for youth leaving state facilities are administered at both the state and local level by either DYS or local juvenile courts.

#### Status Offenses

In Massachusetts, running away from home, repeatedly disobeying the lawful commands of a parent or guardian, truancy, and failing to obey school regulations are status offense behaviors. Status offense cases are classified as children in need of service. The juvenile court has jurisdiction over status offenders and delinquents.
